Achievers' Day Celebrated at GITAM

- 82% Students Placed in 100 Companies
- GITAMITES bagged more than 125 multiple offers
- VM Ware offered Rs.11 Lakh and COMMVAULT Rs.10 Lakhs

School of Technology (SoT) and GITAM Hyderabad Business School (GHBS) of GITAM deemed to be University, Hyderabad celebrated Achievers' Day to hand over the offers of appointments to selected students of Engineering and Management streams at its Campus on 27th March 2018. A total of 600 students have been placed through the institute's Campus Placements process. About 100 companies participated in the final placements. GITAMITES bagged more than 125 multiple offers.

About 82% students of B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA were selected in the campus recruitment drives, which were organized by both IT and core companies. VMWare selected three GITAMITES with a salary of Rs.11 lakh per annum, Commvault Rs.10 lakhs, Byju's Rs.9.5 lakhs, Teradata Rs.7.5 lakhs, Karvy Rs.7.42 lakhs, Zoho Corporation Rs.6.5 lakhs, per annum. About 15 companies offered CTC of more than Rs.5 lakh packages.

IBM recruited 70 engineering students from GITAM Hyderabad Campus. Companies like Amazon (79), Genpact (50), NTT Data (47), Value Momentum (27), Virtusa (23) recruited students from GITAM Hyderabad. Other companies like Rockwell Collins, Mindtree, Portware, TechAspect, LiquidHub, FactSet, Reliance Jio, Times Group, Oracle, Aditya Birla, Asian Paints and Mahindra Finance visited GITAM and selected the budding engineers as per their choice.

The Achievers' Day Celebration began at 2.30 PM. Students heard messages from the Chief Guest, Hon'ble Pro Vice-Chancellor and Directors. Dr. Nukala Narendar Reddy, Ph.D, Air Commodore, Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps Directorate, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana graced this occasion as chief guest. He said that students need to focus on their skill sets. Dr. N.N.Reddy advised the achievers, they try to be an employer in future and they have grown as job creators but not the job seekers. "It is an honour to be with young achievers. The youth is the future of the country and education the only weapon that will stay lifelong with you. I'm glad to be here" he added.

Prof. N.Siva Prasad, Pro Vice-Chancellor said that the university wants to see more entrepreneurs in future rather than job seekers. These impressive placement figures reflect our commitment to secure for our students the most rewarding jobs, he told. He appreciated the tireless efforts of the achievers, Training & Placements Department and the faculty.
