GITAM INTRODUCING THE CONCEPT OF MINOR PROGRAM:

- **GITAM University understands the need of a student to venture beyond their branch. The Minor Programs offered by the university are brilliant avenues for learning something new. For example the students can take up Business Analytics or Logistics or even Photography to fulfill their dreams and also to meet the industry needs.**
- **GITAM University is introducing the concept of Minor program in all Institutes from the 2017-18 academic year. The new mechanism which allows the students to pursue what interests them. Any course offered by the University to which you have fulfilled the prerequisites. This means that a second year EEE student can do a computer minor program if he wishes to. He can also do a Management or Humanities.**
- **This facilitates the student to acquire expertise in the multidisciplinary fronts in addition to his major. The Minor program consists of 15 credits and 3 courses of each 3 credits which give general exposure to a student in the subject area. A mini project of 6 credits also included in the structure.**
- **Admission will be based on the merit list particularly students who got 7.0 CGPA at the end of 1st year only eligible to study minor programs. The assessment of the student's performance in all courses including project shall be based on continuous evaluation (100 marks).**
- **The Primary educational objective of a minor is to impart necessary skills and tools in the areas of the candidate's choice. This facilitates the student to acquire expertise in the multidisciplinary areas in addition to his major.**
