1. PG SCHOLARSHIP (GATE/GPAT/CEED)

AICTE in order to ensure development of technical education in India awards Post Graduate Scholarship of Rs. 12,400/- per month to full-time GATE/GPAT/CEED qualified students admitted to AICTE approved post graduate programs in AICTE approved Institutions/ University Departments as per AICTE approved intake.

Only GATE/GPAT qualified candidates are eligible for GATE/GPAT scholarship

Admissions before or after GATE/GPAT validity shall not be considered for GATE/GPAT scholarship

Scholarship is awarded to full time GATE/GPAT qualified students admitted to M.E. / M. Tech / M. Arch and M.Pharma courses in AICTE approved Institutions / Colleges @Rs. 12,400/- PM/ student.

The girl candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree level course OR Second year of Degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year. Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study

Applications will be invited once in a year through National e-Scholarship Portal of the Government of India.

Saksham is a MHRD Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing encouragement and support to **specially-abled children** to pursue technical education. This is an attempt to give every young student, who is otherwise specially-abled, the opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through technical education/ knowledge.

- Scholarship for Differently Abled Students under SAKSHAM Scheme Implemented by All India Council For Technical Education, New Delhi.

ELIGIBILITY

- Specially-abled student, having disability of not less than 40%.
- Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study

SWANATH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME for children from any one of the following categories:

1. Orphan

2. Either or both parents died due to Covid-19
3. Wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) to provide them financial support of Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study.

6. SUPPORT TO STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATING IN COMPETITION ABROAD (SSPCA)

The objective of the scheme is to provide travel assistance registration fees to a team of minimum 2 to 10 students for attending competition at international level in order to encourage engineering students to improve their field of technical education.

ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Team of Students (2 to 10) in the field of technical education must be enrolled and undergoing a technical course notified by the council in a AICTE approved technical institutions.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Scheme will provide assistance of Rs. 1.00 Lakh as a package inclusive of all related expenses, to the eligible students as per the scheme without putting any barrier on head of expenditure

7. An “AICTE-INAE Travel Grant Scheme” For Engineering Students

UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION - MHRD UGC SCHOLARSHIPS

1. ISHAN UDAY - SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR NORTH EASTERN REGION

The Ministry of HRD and the University Grants Commission has taken special interest with regard to promotion of higher education in the NER. For improving the GER, promoting higher education and for encouraging children belonging to economically weaker section of the NE region, the UGC has decided to launch "IshanUday" Special Scholarship Scheme for North Eastern Region from academic session 2014-15. Before launching the scheme the UGC undertook wide ranging consultations with State Governments and Central & State Universities of the NE region, the Ministry of HRD, the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region, the North Eastern Council, Shillong and other stakeholders.

2. PG INDIRA GANDHI SCHOLARSHIP FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD

It is observed that number of girls as against boys in certain states is declining which is a matter of great concern. The females are even forced to give birth to male child. In such circumstances education of women needs to be used and effective means for their empowerment and education will prepare them to have a control over their lives. The mindset which militates against the girl child could not keep pace with economic progress and literacy. The Government of India declared elementary education as a basic human right of every child. The Union Government of India has taken various steps to uplift the status of women by implementing various schemes including free education for girls. In order to achieve and promote girls education, UGC has introduced a Post Graduate Indira Gandhi

Scholarship for Single Girl Child with an aim to compensate direct costs of girl education to all levels especially for such girls who happen to be the only girl child in their family.

4. UGC RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS IN SCIENCE FOR MERITORIOUS STUDENTS.

The Research Fellowship in Sciences for meritorious students (RFSMS) scheme of the UGC is open to candidates who have registered for **Ph.D.** in Science in Universities with Potential for Excellence/Centres with Potential for Excellence/Centres of Advance Studies and Department of Special Assistance identified by UGC.

5. RAJIV GANDHI NATIONAL FELLOWSHIP

The Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship (RGNF) Scheme for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes is formulated and funded by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and Ministry of Tribal Affairs. The scheme is open to candidates who belong to Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe and wish to pursue higher studies such as regular and full **time M.Phil. and Ph.D degrees** in Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences and Engineering & Technology. There are 1333 slots for Scheduled Caste and 667 slots for Scheduled Tribe candidates every year for all the subjects. 3% fellowships are reserved for the Physically Handicapped SC/ST candidates as per provision laid down by the Govt. of India.

6. JUNIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP (JRF) AND RESEARCH ASSOCIATESHIP (RA) FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

The scheme was initiated keeping in view the political and cultural bilateral relations of India with other developing countries of Asia, Africa and Latin America. The scheme has opened new vistas for foreign students and teachers, enabling them to come to India and undertake advanced studies and research in sciences, humanities and social sciences in Indian Universities.

7. JUNIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP IN SCIENCE, HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES

The Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) scheme of the University Grants Commission (UGC) is open to candidates who qualify in the National Eligibility Testing (NET) of the UGC and the UGC-Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) joint test. However, please note that these are qualifying tests only and do not bestow a fellowship upon the candidate.

8. MAULANA AZAD NATIONAL FELLOWSHIP FOR MINORITY STUDENTS

The Maulana Azad National Fellowship for Minority Students is formulated and funded by Ministry of Minority Affairs. The scheme is open to candidates who belong to one of the Minority Community i.e. **Muslim, Sikh, Parsi, Buddhist & Christian** and wish to pursue higher studies such as regular and full time M.Phil/Ph.D. degrees in Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences and Engineering & Technology. There are 756 slots every year for all the subjects. 3% fellowships are reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates belonging to Minority Candidates as per provision laid down by the Government of India.

9. CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (CSSS)

RATE OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The rate of scholarship is Rs.10000/- per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20000/- per annum at PostGraduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/Integrated course would get Rs.20000/- per annum in the 4th and 5th year. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech., B.Engg would get scholarship up to graduation level.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SCHEME AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1) National Scholarship Portal (NSP) www.scholarships.gov.in will be opened for online application in the month of June-July every year.
- 2) Class XII pass out students of the current Academic Year, who are above 80th percentile of the respective State Education Boards (SEBs) are eligible under the scheme and can apply on National Scholarship Portal (www.scholarship.gov.in), before the cut-off date. Physical application would not be accepted.
- 3) The online applications would be verified at two levels: (i) By the Institute where the student is studying. (ii) By the respective State Education Board.
- 4) Applicant is required to submit requisite documents, such as [Class 12th mark sheet, Income Certificate] to the Institute.
- 5) Application which is not verified either by the institute or by the concerned State Education Board or by both will be treated as „Invalid“.
- 6) Merit list as per the State allocated quota would be generated from the verified applications.
