



# Performing Arts & Cultural Club – Rangasthalam Constitution

## Mission Statement

To create a vibrant campus experience by organizing activities in the performing arts and cultural fields, and by conducting the annual *Fest Week* in collaboration with other college clubs. We strive for excellence in performance through teamwork, multitasking, and leadership, while fostering positive relationships among students.

## Vision Statement

To nurture and showcase the artistic talents of GIMSR students, transforming the club into a cultural hub of national repute. We aim to promote inclusivity, kinship, and cultural expression while expanding our programs to include collaborations with other colleges and participation in external events.

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## Governance

- The club will be governed by a **student committee** formed at the beginning of each academic year.
- Each batch will have **equal representation** in terms of numbers and gender.
- **Presidents**: Selected from the senior-most batch.
- **Vice Presidents**: Selected from the penultimate senior batch.
- Representation across domains will include both batches.
- A **faculty committee** (with a chairperson) will guide all club events and activities.
- Presidents, Vice Presidents, and committee members shall wear the **club jewels** at meetings and college functions.
- For large-scale events (e.g., Annual College Week/Day), the committee will form **sub-committees** with volunteers from all batches.

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## Club Meetings

- Minimum of **4 meetings per academic year** (one with the Faculty Committee).
- Meetings will be chaired by the **student presidents** and **faculty chairperson**.
- A **60% quorum** of the student committee is required.
- **Minutes** will be recorded by Vice Presidents, circulated to all committee members and class representatives within a week (after faculty approval).
- Minutes will be **ratified** at the next meeting before decisions take effect.
- Additional meetings can be called for specific event planning.
- Every member has the right to be heard, and all speakers must address the Chairperson/Presidents.

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## Club Activities

- Conduct **Annual College Week/Day** in line with the academic calendar.
- Maintain the **inter-batch competition format** for cultural events.
- Invite participation from other colleges within the University (special/guest category).
- Conduct at least **one workshop/seminar/talk** on performing arts each year.
- Workshops/seminars will be open to all University colleges.
- Encourage students to participate in external cultural events (with prior academic approval).
- Celebrate **Ethnic Day** annually on the **first Saturday of June**.
- Support other college departments by performing skits, dances, or musical shows during their events.
- Collaborate with the **Helping Hearts Club** to organize workshops for underprivileged schools.
- Organize **Fest Week** annually in partnership with the administration and other clubs.
- Manage event finances responsibly, with **fund-raising** where needed, and donate surplus funds after settlements.

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## General Guidelines

- Committee members may be replaced if duties are not performed efficiently.
- Maintain communication via a **mailing group** and **WhatsApp group** (faculty approval required before forwarding external messages).
- Create and manage **social media pages** and, in time, a club website.
- The **Presidents** and **Faculty Chairperson** shall act as admins for online platforms.

- The **club logo** shall be used responsibly, altered only once every 3 years.
- Respect the **mission, vision, and logo** of the club.
- Maintain **archives** year-on-year in collaboration with the AIYRA Club.
- All **financial matters** must be approved by the Faculty Chairperson/Committee before execution.
- Discuss and pursue **short-term, mid-term, and long-term goals**, including:
  - Club activity space.
  - Annual awards (Best Singer, Best Dancer, Best Actor).
  - Opening a club bank account.
  - Presenting “College Colours” awards for outstanding achievements in performing arts.
  - Formation of **Special Interest Groups (SIGs)**.
- This constitution may be **amended** by the acting Presidents in consultation with Faculty Heads as required.
